

## Environmental Policy

Newport Unlimited is a private company limited by guarantee. Its sponsor partners are the Welsh Assembly Government and Newport City Council. The principal activity of the company is to assist, promote, encourage, undertake and secure the regeneration and development in the physical and economic environment of designated priority areas within the City of Newport.

Through its day to day operations Newport Unlimited has an impact on the environment, arising mainly from consumption of resources (principally energy, water and paper), and the generation of waste.

We are committed to minimising this impact by seeking continual environmental improvements, preventing pollution and complying with relevant environmental legislation. We will achieve this through:

- Raising the awareness and understanding of all staff of environmental issues and how their actions impact.
- Reducing energy consumption through 'smarter', more responsible working practices.
- Reducing the level of waste going to landfill by re-using materials wherever practicable and through recycling.
- Promoting the adoption of sustainable practices when working with partners in both the private and public sectors.

To monitor progress against these commitments we will also develop a comprehensive set of aspirational improvement targets.

This policy relates primarily to the administrative aspects of our day to day operations.

We will also seek to promote environmentally sustainable solutions within our development programme. Wherever development opportunities arise, we will endeavour to ensure that they are undertaken in line with good environmental practice and the principles of sustainable development.

This Environmental Policy will be reviewed and updated annually and will be made available to all interested parties.
